- Travel north to the 49th Parallel and visit Montana's Stonehenge Air Museum, Lundeen Heritage Museum, and experience black powder shooters.

- Optional Red Bus tours in Glacier National Park, hiking in the park, or take the North Fork gravel road to scenic Polebridge, MT.
- Travel around Flathead Lake to the Miracle of America Museum in Polson, MT.

- Possible track time at Montana Raceway
- Dinner at the summit of Big Mountain (optional)
