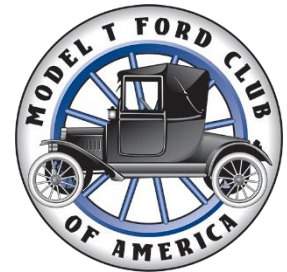

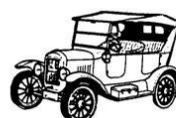
****Club Shirts ****
